Domestic utensils and weapons containing copper were used before similar objects of iron. Silver and gold have always been regarded as precious metals and have long been used for ornaments and money. The Latin words cuprum, argentum, and aurum give us the symbols Cu, Ag, and Au. 394.

Occurrence of Copper.--Copper, both free and combined, is an abundant element. Like many other metals copper occurs as ores, that is, mineral compounds from which the metal can be profitably extracted; sometimes the term ore is applied to rock containing metal, e.g. quartz-bearing gold is called gold ore. Free or native copper is mined in large quantities in northern Michigan on the shores of Lake Superior. The important copper ores are copper sulphide (chalcocite, copper glance, Cu_2S), copper oxide (cuprite, ruby ore, Cu_2O), the copper-iron sulphides (copper pyrites, chalcopyrite,...
