

The two edicts of the 14th September, 1811, may be considered as the culminating point of the legislation which goes by the name of Stein and Hardenberg. Nothing could exceed the malicious joy of the aristocratic French party when Steins dismissal, on the 24th November, appeared in the Gazette. Count York, whose characteristic letter we have already quoted, again committed his views to paper in a communication to Lieut. -Colonel von Oppen, and melancholy it is indeed that such a disgraceful record of narrow-mindedness and ignorance should have come down to us on the part of one who was otherwise a good man and an excellent officer. Our foreign relations begin to take a more favourable aspect; and our home affairs a more rational turn. One silly head has been already crushed; the other vile brood will stifle in their own venom. I hope things will soon improve. If calm reason holds sway as we hope, and fortune turns in our favour, I trust that the withered stem, animated afresh, will yet blossom and bear fruit. Nattergeschmeiss--lit. , excrement of vipers. We need not feel surprised at the narrowminded and ignorant sentiments of a man of such a stamp as York. They are common to all countries alike. France had her Stein in Turgot some thirty years before this period, and he experienced the same fate. We may be here pardoned a short digression in order, for the sake of comparison, to consider the preamble...
